I AM DEEPLY DISTRESSED TO INFORM YOU, REPORT JUST RECEIVED, STATES YOUR SON CAPTIAN MONT F STEPHENSEN WHO WAS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED MISSING IN ACTION WAS KILLED IN ACTION DECEMBER TWENTYTHIRD, NINETEEN FORTYFOUR IN GERMANY, SECRETARY OF WAR ASKS THAT I EXPRESS HIS DEEPEST SYMPATHY IN YOUR LOSS AND HIS REGREETS THAT UNAVOIDABLE CIRCUMSTANCES MADE IT NECESSARY THE UNUSAL LAPSE OF TIME REPORTING YOUR SONS DEATH TO YOU.
